2025 Award Categories and Qualifications:

Superintendent of the Year

Who is eligible:

- Superintendents or Associate/Assistant Superintendents who are responsible for maintenance operations.
- Must be a current member of NCPSMA.
- Must be nominated by an active NCPSMA member from the same district.

Required nomination materials:

- A signed letter of nomination from an active member.
 - A photo of the nominee (on a separate page).
 - A narrative biographical sketch (no more than two pages) outlining the nominee’s contributions to NCPSMA and professional achievements.

Maintenance Director of the Year

Who is eligible:

- The direct head of a school maintenance department.
- Must currently work in a North Carolina educational system.
- Must have been an active NCPSMA member for the last five (5) consecutive years.
- Cannot be the current NCPSMA State President.
- Must be nominated by an active NCPSMA member from the same district.

Required nomination materials:

- A signed letter of nomination from an active member.
- A photo of the nominee (on a separate page).
- A narrative biographical sketch (no more than two pages) outlining the nominee’s contributions to NCPSMA and professional achievements.

Maintenance Employee of the Year

Who is eligible:

- Any maintenance staff member who is not the director.
- Must currently work in a North Carolina educational system.
- Must have been an active NCPSMA member for the last five (5) consecutive years.
- Cannot be the current NCPSMA State President.
- Must be nominated by an active NCPSMA member from the same district.

Required nomination materials:

- A signed letter of nomination from an active member.
- A photo of the nominee (on a separate page).
- A narrative biographical sketch (no more than two pages) outlining the nominee's contributions to NCPSMA and professional achievements.

Important Notes:

- Only **one nominee per category per LEA** is allowed. If multiple nominations in the same category are received from the same LEA, all nominees in that category will be disqualified (as per NCPSMA Advisory Council ruling, May 2016).
- Nominations must be submitted by **Friday, August 8, 2025**.
